The undersigned acknowledges that due to the nature of the cremation process, any material on the remains of the Pet, such as collars, tags, etc., will be destroyed if not removed. Accordingly, the undersigned has removed any such material or, if the material is present on the Pet's remains, the undersigned understands it will either be destroyed or removed and disposed of by the Crematory.

CREMATION PROCESS: The process of reducing your pet's body to mineral form by exposure to intense heat and vaporization is then returned to its elements. The cremated remains are then pulverized to get a coarse sand-like powder with uniform consistency. These cremated remains are then transferred into a sealed plastic bag, and then placed in a temporary container or an urn selected by the owner and then returned to the owner or legal representative.

PRIVATE CREMATION: A private cremation is when your beloved animal friend is placed privately into the cremation chamber without any other pets. This cremation option includes a private cremation process, placement of cremated remains into an urn, delivery or pick-up service of cremated remains, and an issuance of a certificate of cremation.

MEMORIAL CREMATION: A memorial cremation is an option for the owner who does NOT wish to have the cremated remains returned back to the family. During this type of cremation, multiple animals are cremated together and the cremated remains are not able to be separated. The cremated remains are then scattered respectfully back to the earth.
